A guide to parent inclusion

Our programme is combined with a parent rota sign up which we email out at the beginning of each term. We explain that we need additional help with residentials and trips too. We have had parents run meetings on first aid, cricket and drama

1st & 7th Roundhay Guides



We always ask parents to complete the part of the Joining Guides form. We also send home notes, email, phone and text. We do get help when we need it

2nd Rawdon (Trinity) Rainbows



We email parents and have received help with cooking, camp fires and messy things (generally when we need extra help per patrol)

1st Barwick (All Saint's) Guides



Our parents volunteer to help for day trips or transport to and from residentials

9th Horsforth Brownies



We contact parents via email and they help with lifts to and from places as well as a parent rota. We had one parent who came and taught resuscitation when we were doing the First Aid badge. We also have a parent who has made aprons for all the Brownies as she can't come and help at meetings, so it's always worth asking for help with anything!

1st Esholt Brownies



We chat to parents face to face and send out a termly letter asking parents to sign up to a rota. We ask for help on rota basis, skills sessions and for residentials / trips

2nd Rawdon (Trinity) Rainbows



We contact parents via email and phone as soon as their daughter joins. They are informed that they are expected to help with weekly rota. Some parents also help with specific skill sessions. Several parents have been encouraged and supported to complete their LQ and they will be taking over the running of the unit in the near future
